COMPOSITION:	46% Merlot, Seven Hills and Stillwater Creek Vineyard 31% Cabernet Sauvignon, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 23% Cabernet Franc, Stillwater Creek Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.58 TA 0.64 g/100mL Alcohol 13.9% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. Inoculated with a <i>Saccharomyces cerevisiae</i> species after cold soaking. The cap was punched down three times per day. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 67% New Allier and Tronçais French oak Aged 21 months
CASES PRODUCED:	334 cases
RELEASE DATE:	August 15, 2005
SENSORY NOTES:	The name Big Sky reflects the distinct quality of this huge wine. Big and bold with loads of mouth watering flavors, perfectly laced with natural acidity derived from the fruit of Stillwater Creek Vineyard.
