COMPOSITION:	Pepper Bridge Vineyard Seven Hills Vineyard McClellan Estate Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.64 TA 0.61 g/100mL Alcohol 13.9% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. Inoculated with a <i>Saccharomyces cerevisiae</i> species after cold soaking. The cap was punched down three times per day. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 50% New oak Aged 21 months
CASES PRODUCED:	304 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	June 21, 2007
RELEASE DATE:	October 1, 2007
SENSORY NOTES:	This elegant wine begins with powerful scents of flowers, blackberry, ripe wild berries, and baking spices. A full-bodied wine that offers layers of seductive ripe black cherry and red berry fruit flavors with silky tannins that lead to a long finish.
