APPELLATION:	Columbia Valley
COMPOSITION:	53% Sangiovese, Watkins Vineyard 37% Cabernet Franc, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 10% Merlot, Seven Hills Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.62 TA 0.59 g/100mL Alcohol 14.1% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 40% New French oak Aged 21 months
CASES PRODUCED:	147 cases
RELEASE DATE:	October 1, 2007
ACCOLADES:	94 Points – Wine & Spirits One of the Top 100 Wines of the Year – Wine & Spirits
SENSORY NOTES:	This wine is dedicated to Theresa and Sam Laurella, whose family has been making wine in the Walla Walla Valley since the early 1900's. Sam's first crush was sixty years ago and today he continues his winemaking tradition by helping at Saviah Cellars.

Our Laurella is styled in a super-Tuscan fashion sharing new world winemaking with traditional grape varietals creating a luscious, balanced wine with spicy ripe cranberry and cherry tones followed by a silky long finish.
