COMPOSITION:	62% Cabernet Sauvignon, Pepper Bridge Vineyard 31% Merlot, Seven Hills Vineyard 7% Cabernet Franc, McClellan Estate Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.67 TA 0.64 g/100mL Alcohol 13.9% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. Inoculated with a <i>Saccharomyces cerevisiae</i> species after cold soaking. The cap was punched down three times per day. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 60% New oak Aged 16 months
CASES PRODUCED:	304 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	February 27, 2007
RELEASE DATE:	April 1, 2007
SENSORY NOTES:	This classic Left Bank Bordeaux-style blend begins with powerful scents of flowers, blackberry, ripe wild berries, and baking spices. The Une Vallée is a full-bodied wine that offers layers of seductive ripe black cherry and red berry fruit flavors with silky tannins that lead to a wonderfully smooth finish.
