COMPOSITION:	61% Merlot, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 8% Cabernet Franc, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 3% Malbec, McClellan Estate Vineyard 2% Petit Verdot, McClellan Estate Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.59 TA 0.61 g/100mL Alcohol 14.2% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing the young wine was transferred to barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	20 months in small oak barrels 60% New Allier and Tronçais French oak
CASES PRODUCED:	632 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	June 11, 2009
RELEASE DATE:	October 1, 2010
SENSORY NOTES:	This stellar red is mouth filling and rich with a superb balance of solid ripe dark fruit and black current flavors with a touch of dried herb flavors and a little chocolate and spice on the finish. The blend of complex flavors is joined with a lush mouth feel and a wonderful mid-palate experience. Bright acids and silky-smooth tannins give this extraordinary wine extra lift and precision.
