FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 50% New oak Aged 20 months
CASES PRODUCED:	640 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	June 11, 2009
RELEASE DATE:	September 1, 2009
SENSORY NOTES:	Made with fruit from the valley's finest vineyards including Pepper Bridge Vineyard, Seven Hills Vineyard, and McClellan Estate Vineyard, this wine is very smooth! The powerful scents of flowers, blackberry, ripe wild berries, and baking spices will captivate you. After the first mouthful, you'll be seduced by the layers of ripe black cherry and red berry fruit flavors and silky tannins that lead to a long, rewarding finish.
