VINEYARDS:	Stillwater Creek Vineyard Stillwater Creek Vineyard located in the Frenchman Hills of Washington State's Columbia Valley.
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.59 TA 0.61 g/100mL Alcohol 14.2% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. 50% whole berry primary fermentation. Why? Whole berries trap volatile aroma compounds which are normally blown off during the most active phase of fermentation. This increases the varietal characters of the finished wine. The cap is punched down by hand 3 times per day.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 40% New French oak Aged 17 months
CASES PRODUCED:	220 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	February 17, 2009
RELEASE DATE:	April 1, 2010
