TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.69 TA 0.60 g/100mL Alcohol 14.1% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 40% New French oak Aged 17 months
CASES PRODUCED:	243 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	February 11, 2010
RELEASE DATE:	May 1, 2010
SENSORY NOTES:	Beautiful inky purple wine shows mountain berries, plum and a touch of spice on the nose. The wine has great balance with a savory spicy note mingling with big Walla Walla Valley fruit and a touch of chocolate. The finish is long and delicious.
