COMPOSITION:	57% Cabernet Sauvignon, Pepper Bridge Vineyard 36% Merlot, Seven Hills Vineyard 7% Cabernet Franc, Stillwater Creek Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH - 3.71 TA - 0.59 g/100mL Alcohol - 14.1%
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 60% New oak Aged 17 months
