APELLATION:	Walla Walla Valley
COMPOSITION:	56% Cabernet Sauvignon, Pepper Bridge and McClellan Vineyards 38% Merlot, Seven Hills Vineyard 6% Cabernet Franc, Watermill Estate Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH - 3.72 • TA - 0.58 g/100mL • Alcohol - 14.1%
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	100% French oak barrels 60% New oak Aged 17 months
CASES PRODUCED:	382 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	February 11, 2010
RELEASE DATE:	April 1, 2010
TASTING NOTES:	It's our 9 th release of this Walla Walla Valley Bordeaux-style blend. I have said many times before, that if I could make only one wine this would be the one. The 2008 may go down as my favorite bottling of Une Vallée since our first release of this wine. Only time will tell...but I have a feeling this one will shine in a vertical tasting down the road. You might want to pick up a few more bottles to tuck away for future enjoyment.
