VINEYARDS:	Watermill Estate Vineyard McClellan Estate Vineyard Pepper Bridge Vineyards
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.72 TA 0.59 g/100mL Alcohol 14.1% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	Aged 17 months in small oak barrels 40% New French oak
CASES PRODUCED:	290 cases
BOTTLING DATE:	February 24, 2011
RELEASE DATE:	April 1, 2012
SENSORY NOTES:	What a wonderful surprise to find that Malbec loves to grow so well here in the Walla Walla Valley! This Malbec really shows classic varietal characteristics. Beautiful inky color, with scents of blackberries, savory spice and berry cobbler.
