three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to

French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

BARREL AGING: Aged 18 months in 225 L barrels

40% new French oak

CASES PRODUCED: 825 cases

BOTTLING DATE: March 21, 2012

RELEASE DATE: October 1, 2012

SENSORY NOTES: A delicious, classic Cabernet Sauvignon from the Walla Walla

Valley. 2010 was a cooler vintage in Washington State, yet this wine shows the distinctive characteristics of perfectly ripened fruit due to the excellent viticultural practices which brought balance to the vineyard blocks resulting in a beautiful well

balanced wine. In other words...we hung less fruit, made less wine

but are very happy with the results.
