- APPELLATION:** Yakima Valley
- COMPOSITION:** 44% Grenache • 28% Syrah • 28% Mourvedre  
Elephant Mountain Vineyard
- TECHNICAL NOTES:** pH 3.42  
TA 0.66 g/100mL  
Alcohol 14.3% By Volume
- FERMENTATION:** Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
- BARREL AGING:** Aged 20 months in small French oak barrels  
14% New French oak barrels
- CASES PRODUCED:** 168 Cases
- RELEASE DATE:** April 1, 2013
- SENSORY NOTES:** This Southern Rhône Valley-style blend is simply delicious! The nose seduces with aromas of black plums, red cherries and raspberries with hints of sage and subtle floral notes. The palate is generous and fruit-driven with a core of kirsch style red fruits and is framed by wet stone, licorice and spice. An elegant, yet intensely flavored wine that is a perfect match for Mediterranean cuisine.
