FERMENTATION: Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down

three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French

oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING: 17 months in French oak barrels, 60% new

CASES PRODUCED: 320 cases

RELEASE DATE: October 1, 2013

SENSORY NOTES: The 2011 vintage, again a very cool vintage, produced some spectacular
