APPELLATION:	Walla Walla Valley
COMPOSITION:	55% Cabernet Sauvignon, McClellan Estate Vineyard 42% Merlot, Anna Marie and Seven Hills Vineyards 3% Petit Verdot, Anna Marie Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.72 TA 0.60 g/100mL Alcohol 14.1% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
AGING:	17 months in French oak barrels, 60% new
CASES PRODUCED:	320 cases
RELEASE DATE:	October 1, 2013
SENSORY NOTES:	The 2011 vintage, again a very cool vintage, produced some spectacular wines including our flagship blend, Une Vallée. This wine was created from our most coveted blocks of fruit in the Walla Walla Valley. One word description....delicious! Full-bodied, artfully balanced acidity with silky smooth tannins and a long pleasing finish. This wine will age nicely and you will be handsomely rewarded for your patience!
