<b>COMPOSITION:</b>	82% Tempranillo, 12% Syrah, 6% Grenache
<b>TECHNICAL NOTES:</b>	pH 3.84 TA 0.54 g/100mL Alcohol 14.2% By Volume
<b>FERMENTATION:</b>	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
<b>AGING:</b>	17 months in French oak barrels, 20% new

It is nicely structured with smooth tannins and good acidity. Enjoy!
