FERMENTATION:

Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING:

17 months in French oak barrels, 60% new

The 2012 vintage of our flagship blend, Une Vallée is a beautiful expression of the nearly perfect growing conditions from our most coveted blocks of fruit in the Walla Walla Valley.
