Fermentation:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

Sensory Notes:	2013 was an excellent vintage in the Walla Walla Valley resulting in perfectly ripe fruit. The wine is bursting with harmonious fruit flavors consisting of cassis, black cherry, and plum. A touch of cocoa nibs and a nice frame of spicy oak. Balanced and velvety, this cab will build on your palate and treat you with a smooth, long finish.
