2013 was an excellent vintage in the Walla Walla Valley resulting in perfectly ripe fruit. The wine is bursting with harmonious fruit flavors consisting of cassis, black cherry, and plum. A touch of cocoa nibs and a nice frame of spicy oak. Balanced and velvety, this cab will build on your palate and treat you with a smooth, long finish.
