Sensory Notes:	The Walla Walla Valley is my favorite region in Washington State for Syrah. This Syrah really expresses classic Walla Walla traits. This is a delicious, full-bodied wine with a touch of smoky spice and black fruit aromas on the nose. Concentrated flavors of cherry and blackberry, with a silky tannin profile. An elegant wine with abundant flavors that persist long after the wine is gone. Enjoy!

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
