stirred weekly to contribute to a rich mouth feel. Secondary

fermentation was encouraged until the acidity was perfectly balanced.

AGING: 9 months in French oak barrels, 25% new

SENSORY NOTES: I love this one acre block of Clone 75 Chardonnay. The 2014 vintage

wine marks the twelfth year that we have crafted a vineyard designate from this block at Stillwater Creek Vineyard. Delicious aromas of pear, citrus and apple pie. Flavors show crisp pear and tropical fruits mingling with a hint of barrel spice. A food-friendly wine to enjoy with crab cakes, scallops, roasted pork with apples, or mushrooms sautéed in

butter.
