Watermill Estate Vineyard (40%)

TECHNICAL NOTES:

FERMENTATION:

Partially whole cluster, partially destemmed and crushed into open top fermenters with cap punched down by hand two-three times per day. Secondary fermentation finished in barrel.

AGING:

17 months in French oak barrels, 16% new

This reserve quality Syrah from The Rocks District of Milton-Freewater carries the captivating aromatics, flavors and textural quality that is a signature of the soils of these two top notch vineyards. This wine is loaded with delicious flavors of dark fruit and black olive framed by a velvety texture and supple richness that give way to a long delicious finish. Enjoy!
