SENSORY NOTES: 2012 was an excellent vintage in Washington State. All of these

vineyards sites are all located in the southern end of the valley with three different soil types ranging from basalt cobbles to wind and water deposited silt loam. A beautifully balanced, nicely structured wine bursting with savory ripe red fruit and black fruit flavors complemented by mineral, sweet herb and tobacco notes with a long, lingering finish.
