TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.69 TA 0.58 g/100mL Alcohol 14.8% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down two times per day by hand. The wine was transferred to American oak barrels to complete fermentation.
AGING:	23 Months French oak barrels, 60% new

SENSORY NOTES:	Only twelve barrels of The Jack Reserve Red Wine were crafted showcasing what a terrific vintage 2012 delivered. A beautiful garnet color in the glass with classic Cabernet flavors of black cherries, plum and black currant complemented by floral, rocky, dried thyme, anise, spice box and vanilla oak aromas.
