Stillwater Creek Vineyard located in the Frenchman Hills of Washington State's Columbia Valley.

TECHNICAL NOTES:

pH 3.18
TA 0.65 g/100mL
Alcohol 13.8% By Volume

FERMENTATION:

Very slowly fermented in 225 Liter French oak barrels. The lees were stirred weekly to contribute to a rich mouth feel. Secondary fermentation was encouraged until the acidity was perfectly balanced.

AGING:

9 months in French oak barrels, 20% new

250 cases

SENSORY NOTES:

I love this one acre block of Clone 95 Chardonnay. This 2013 vintage wine marks the eleventh year we have crafted a vineyard designate from this block at Stillwater Creek Vineyard. Delicious aromas of pear, citrus and apple pie. Flavors show crisp pear and tropical fruits mingling with a hint of barrel spice. A food friendly wine to enjoy with crab cakes, scallops, pork roasted with apples, or mushrooms sautéed in butter.
