TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.84 TA 0.54 g/100mL Alcohol 14.6% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down two times per day by hand. The wine was transferred to oak barrels to complete fermentation.
AGING:	French oak barrels, 30% new
