COMPOSITION:	69% Merlot, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 23% Cabernet Sauvignon, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 3% Cabernet Franc, Stillwater Creek Vineyard 3% Malbec, McClellan Estate Vineyard 2% Petit Verdot, Stillwater Creek Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.65 TA 0.55 g/100mL Alcohol 14.2% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing the young wine was transferred to barrels to complete fermentation.
BARREL AGING:	Aged 20 months in small oak barrels 60% New Allier and Tronçais French oak
CASES PRODUCED:	521 Cases
ACCLAIM:	90 points Wine Spectator
BOTTLING DATE:	June 9, 2010
RELEASE DATE:	October 1, 2011
SENSORY NOTES:	2008 proved to be sensational for this wine. Rich, ripe, focused with black cherry, plum, berry and savory notes on the nose. Dark fruit, earth and spice flavors are mouth coating with excellent balance. The finish reveals notes of dark cocoa and sweet barrel spice.
