Single Clone Selection – Dijon 75

Stillwater Creek Vineyard located in the Frenchman Hills of Washington State's Columbia Valley.

**TECHNICAL NOTES:** pH 3.47  
TA 0.63 g/100mL  
Alcohol 14.1% By Volume

**FERMENTATION:** Very slowly fermented in French oak barrels. The lees were stirred weekly to artfully create a rich mouth feel. Secondary fermentation was encouraged until the acidity was perfectly balanced for our Saviah style of this delicious wine.

**BARREL AGING:** Aged 9 months in small French oak barrels  
25% New French oak

**PRODUCTION:** 165 Cases

**BOTTLING DATE:** June 9, 2010

**RELEASE DATE:** October 1, 2010

**SENSORY NOTES:** Our style of Chardonnay is clean and sophisticated showing beautiful scents of ripe stone fruits, pear, pineapple and Granny Smith apples with a touch of baking spice. Delicious vibrant fruit flavors meld perfectly with the rich mouthfeel and a long refreshing finish. Perfect for an aperitif or excellent with crab cakes, scallops, pork roasted with apples or mushrooms sautéed in butter.
