VINEYARDS:	Funk Estate Vineyard Anna Marie Vineyard Watermill Estate Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.78 TA 0.54 g/100mL Alcohol 14.2% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	The fruit was hand sorted into open top 1.5 ton fermenters. 90% of the fruit was destemmed and crushed, while 10% remained whole cluster. The cap punched down by hand two-three times per day. Secondary fermentation finished in barrel.
BARREL AGING:	Aged 17 months in small oak barrels 20% New French oak
CASES PRODUCED:	382 cases
RELEASE DATE:	October 1, 2012
ACCLAIM:	92 Points - Wine Spectator
SENSORY NOTES:	We are very happy to share this Syrah from three Estate vineyards which we have had the pleasure of working with from their inception. This Syrah really expresses classic Walla Walla traits. Beautiful inky color, with scents of black cherries, sassafras, wet stones, and spice. Silky supple tannins give way to a long delicious finish. This will be a wine you will wish you had stocked up on. A real beauty!
