**FERMENTATION:**

Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing, the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

**AGING:**

21 months in French oak barrels, 100% new

**SENSORY NOTES:**

2012 had near perfect growing conditions, which resulted in this full bodied, deeply colored wine. Plush and opaque, this deep wine opens with perfumed raspberry, dried herb, brown sugar, sweet wood, cherry cola, and cigar box aromas. Sage, black cherry, vanilla, blackberry truffle, and earthy lavender and leather flavors are enriched by the nicely-structured mouthfeel and persistent, pleasing finish. A perfect pairing for grilled lamb chops with Egyptian mint sauce. Enjoy!
