Funk Estate Vineyard (60%)
Watermill Estate Vineyard (40%)

TECHNICAL NOTES:

pH 3.92

FERMENTATION:

Partially whole cluster, partially destemmed and crushed into open top fermenters with cap punched down by hand two-three times per day. Secondary fermentation finished in barrel.

AGING:

17 months in French oak barrels, 16% new

SENSORY NOTES:

100% The Rocks District. Distinctive terroir-driven aroma and flavors only found from Syrah grown in the alluvial soils of the Walla Walla River! This beautiful, inky Syrah from these cobble-strewn vineyards opens with a signature profile of savory, smoky, sweet, cherry and plum aromas. The flavors show an earthy element, almost like liquid rock dancing with nuances of cracked pepper, sweet herbs and toffee. Do yourself a favor and lock this away for at least three to five years. Enjoy!
