100% Syrah

VINEYARDS:

Funk Estate Vineyard, Watermill Estate Vineyard, Lewis and Anna Marie Vineyards

TECHNICAL NOTES:

pH 3.89
TA 0.57 g/100mL
Alcohol 14.5% By Volume

FERMENTATION:

The fruit was hand sorted into open top 1.5 ton fermenters. 90% of the fruit was destemmed and crushed, while 10% remained whole cluster. The cap punched down by hand two or three times per day. Secondary fermentation finished in barrel.

AGING:

17 months French oak barrels, 20% new

CASES PRODUCED:

490 cases

SENSORY NOTES:

The Walla Walla Valley is my favorite region in Washington State for Syrah. This Syrah really expresses classic Walla Walla traits. This is a delicious, full-bodied wine with a touch of smoky spice and black fruit aromas on the nose. Concentrated flavors of cherry and blackberry, with a silky tannin profile. An elegant wine with abundant flavors that persist long after the wine is gone. Enjoy!
