38% Merlot, Anna Marie and Seven Hills Vineyards
6% Cabernet Franc, Dugger Creek Vineyard
6% Petit Verdot, Anna Marie Vineyard

TECHNICAL NOTES:

pH 3.77
TA 0.57 g/100mL
Alcohol 14.6% By Volume

FERMENTATION:

Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING:

17 months in French oak barrels, 60% new

394 cases

November 1, 2015

SENSORY NOTES:

Wow! Easily one of our best Une Vallée's ever. Truly a reserve quality wine, blended from our favorite barrels from the 2013 vintage. A deeply colored garnet red in the glass with beautiful aromas of meaty black cherries, cassia, clove, vanilla, and dark chocolate. The Une Vallée is full-bodied with loads of red and black fruits, spice, sweet herbs, cacao and silky smooth tannins. I am really excited to taste this wine after a few years in the bottle. Enjoy!
