APPELLATION:	Walla Walla Valley
COMPOSITION:	100% Syrah
VINEYARDS:	Funk Estate Vineyard, Watermill Estate Vineyard, Anna Marie Vineyards, Lewis Vineyard
TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.87 TA 0.56 g/100mL Alcohol 14.5% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	The fruit was hand sorted into open top 1.5 ton fermenters. 90% of the fruit was destemmed and crushed, while 10% remained whole cluster. The cap punched down by hand two or three times per day. Secondary fermentation finished in barrel.
AGING:	17 months French oak barrels, 20% new
CASES PRODUCED:	460 cases
ACCLAIM:	93 Points – Wine Enthusiast 92 Points – Wine Spectator Gold – Walla Walla Valley Wine Competition Gold – Seattle Wine Awards
SENSORY NOTES:	This Syrah is a blend of four different vineyards, with each site offering a different component to the overall expression and balance. The two vineyards from The Rocks District, Funk and Watermill Vineyards, contribute to the savory elements of olive, meat and smoke along with black and red fruit. The Anna Marie brings a black fruit component along with a hint of chocolate. A small dollop of Lewis Vineyard offers blackberry preserves and cherry tones. An elegant wine with abundant flavors that persist long after the wine is gone. Enjoy!
