Fermentation:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
Aging:	17 months in French oak barrels, 20% new

Sensory Notes:	A deep ruby color and complex aroma set off this intriguing Tempranillo. Sweet tobacco notes give way to a delicate floral perfume with a hint of the characteristic Rocks funkiness. Caramel, vanilla, and chocolate-dipped red fruit aromas continue to captivate. On the palate, this wine bursts with juicy, spicy flavors of plum and black pepper, with distinct floral and meaty notes. Bright, rounded, and full, each harmonious sip suspends the flavors for a lingering, tantalizing finish.

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
