14% Syrah, Lewis Vineyard

FERMENTATION:

Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing, the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING:

29 months in French oak barrels, 33% new

194 cases

RELEASE DATE:

SENSORY NOTES:

Super Tuscan inspired, but thoroughly Walla Walla in execution. Aromas of black licorice, dried fig, Italian herbs, and black currant are rounded out by well-integrated barrel spices. Sensuous and lush on the palate, with ripe raspberry, tar, and earth flavors. Velvety tannins lead to an exceptionally smooth finish.
