Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was gently punched down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing, the young wine was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

21 months in French oak barrels, 60% new

SENSORY NOTES:

This beautiful, deep wine exudes aromas of black fruits, leather, graphite, baking spices, dried herbs, and luscious caramel, with hints of maple-smoked bacon. The rich mouthfeel and balanced acidity deliver flavors of dark cherry, cocoa powder, violets, and lavender with a long, blackberry jam-infused finish.
