| SENSORY NOTE: | The 2015 vintage produced stellar Cabernet Sauvignon fruit with great concentration of rich, ripe flavors due to ideal conditions in September and October. The wine offers dark fruit aromas, excellent concentration, cassis fruit and refined silky tannins, with red fruit aromas, bright mouthfeel.
