SENSORY NOTES: Dark and robust, this Petit Verdot displays highly perfumed aromas of

cola, Bing cherry, musky vanilla, and dried herbs. Black cherry, plum, violets and sage notes are lush and balanced on the palate. The long, spicy finish adds to the complexity and enjoyment of this unique wine.
