VINEYARD: 100% Syrah

Funk Estate Vineyard located in The Rocks District of Milton-Freewater

FERMENTATION: Small open top stainless steel fermenters. One third whole cluster with

two thirds de-stemmed fruit. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to 500 liter puncheons

to complete fermentation.

AGING: 17 months in French oak puncheons, 20% new

CASES PRODUCED: 228 cases

REVIEW NOTES: The 2016 is another stellar expression of Syrah from The Rocks. This

wine opens with captivating aromas of cured meat, black olive, rocks funk, tobacco leaf and crème de cassis. Elegant on the palate with red and black fruits, roasted coffee, clove, anise, and a distinctive meaty note. A rich, beautiful wine with a lingering finish that beckons another

sip.
