TECHNICAL NOTES:	pH 3.79 TA 0.57 g/100mL Alcohol 14.4% By Volume
FERMENTATION:	All fruit hand-picked and hand sorted. Crushed directly to small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down two times per day. The wine was transferred to 225 Liter oak barrels to complete primary and secondary fermentation.
AGING:	French oak barrels, 10% new
