FERMENTATION: Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was punched down

three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French

oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING: 17 months in French oak barrels, 40% new

RELEASE DATE: October 2018

SENSORY NOTES: The sweet sixteen vintage of our flagship wine is lush and age-

worthy. Opening with expressive aromas of cassis, dark chocolate, black pepper, and well-integrated barrel spice which invite the first sip. Full and palate-flooding, with cinnamon, black plum, and berry cobbler flavors. The tannins are firm and will soften beautifully with cellaring.
