16% Merlot, Anna Marie Vineyard

FERMENTATION: Small open top stainless steel fermenters. The cap was gently punched

down by hand three times per day. After gently pressing, the young wine

was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.

AGING: 27 months in French oak barrels, 33% new

SENSORY NOTES: A Tuscan-inspired blend sharing new world winemaking with traditional

grape varietals, creating an elegant, luscious wine with a core of dark red fruit along with savory sweet herbs on the nose. Flavors showing notes of olive and dried cherry complemented by savory, dusty tannins and a
