

## 2016 HUNT & GATHER RED WINE

APPELLATION: Walla Walla Valley

COMPOSITION: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, McClellan Vineyard

40% Syrah, Funk Estate Vineyard, The Rocks District

TECHNICAL NOTES: pH 3.89

TA 0.57 g/100mL

Alcohol 14.7% By Volume

FERMENTATION: Small open top fermenters. The cap was punched down three times per

day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to

complete fermentation.

AGING: 19 months in French oak barrels, 50% new

CASES PRODUCED: 95 cases

RELEASE DATE: October 2020

SENSORY NOTES: Only four barrels of this limited production wine were produced. The

name alludes to the two synergistic components which were carefully selected and brought together to create a hedonistic wine. Hunt referring to the meaty, earthy, savory and black olive characteristics from our Rocks District Syrah and Gather connoting the Cabernet Sauvignon which provides a flavorful core of blackberry, cassis, cocoa nibs and spice. Barrel aged and then bottled-aged for two years before release, this wine has a supple texture, with polished tannins and a long

generous finish.
