COMPOSITION:

96% Syrah, 4% Viognier

VINEYARD:

Funk Estate Vineyard located in The Rocks District of Milton-Freewater. Distinguished by alluvial soils, consisting of basalt pebbles, cobbles and boulders washed from the Blue Mountains.

FERMENTATION:

Partial whole cluster Syrah co-fermented with 4% whole cluster Viognier.

AGING:

18 months in small French oak puncheons.
25% New.

Amazing aromatic profile with cured meats, peppercorns, blackberry, black raspberry, mandarin, lavender, and cocoa nibs. Rich, full-bodied sensation on the palate showcasing polished tannins and layers of savory, briny olives, licorice, dark berries, and spice.
