barrels to complete primary and secondary fermentation.

AGING: 23 months French oak barrels, 30% new

RELEASE DATE: July 2021

SENSORY NOTES: The Jack Reserve is a limited production wine crafted from handpicked

barrels which are aged nearly two years before bottling. Inky color in the glass, with aromas of ripe blackberries, plum, and cassis, along with notes of violet, pipe tobacco, sandalwood, and rubbed sage. A delicious finish showing vanilla, cocoa nibs, and a touch of spice. A perfect wine
