FERMENTATION:	Small open top stainless steel tanks. The cap was punched down three times per day by hand. Free run juice was transferred to French oak barrels to complete fermentation.
AGING:	17 months in French oak barrels, 20% new

SENSORY NOTES:	2018 was a unicorn vintage with nearly perfect conditions for winegrowing from the beginning to the end. This wine displays distinctive Rocks-influenced characteristics. It opens with aromas of black cherry, plum, cured meats, olive, herb and spice. The palate exhibits velvety tannins with rich, round flavors of black and red fruits, umami, cocoa nibs with a long savory finish. Enjoy! Drink 2021-2031.
