SENSORY NOTES: 2019 was another great vintage for our Chardonnay! Cooler September

temperatures helped preserve the natural freshness in this fruit and provided near perfect growing conditions. The wine opens with lovely aromas of Asian pear and gala apple. It dances on the palate with mouthwatering minerality, delicious pear, citrus and stone fruit, along with a hint of crome brokes and groups lamon. Drink 2020, 2029

with a hint of crème brûlée and creamy lemon. Drink 2020-2028.
