



## 2017 PINOT NOIR

**APPELLATION:**

Walla Walla Valley

**VINEYARDS:**

Couse Creek Vineyard

**TECHNICAL NOTES:**

pH 3.78  
TA 0.64 g/100mL  
Alcohol 14.1% By Volume

**FERMENTATION:**

Partially whole cluster, partially destemmed and crushed into open top fermenters with cap punched down by hand two-three times per day. Secondary fermentation finished in barrel.

**AGING:**

12 months in 228L French oak barrels, 33% New

**CASES PRODUCED:**

112 cases

**SENSORY NOTES:**

This Pinot Noir from Couse Creek Vineyard, a 30-year-old vineyard planted at 1800 feet in elevation, is a unique, rare wine coming from the Walla Walla Valley. A delicate, pale ruby in color, this wine opens with pretty aromas of rose petals, cherry, raspberry, and clove which carry through to the palate. A nicely balanced wine, with bright acidity and delicious finish.. Enjoy!
