SENSORY NOTES: The Funk is a gorgeous expression of Syrah from The Rocks District and

showcases the distinctive characteristics of this exciting location. The wine opens with classic aromas of savory roasted meats, blackberry, red plum, green olive, cocoa nibs, and cracked pepper, with subtle notes of orange blossom. On the palate, the wine delivers rich flavors and hedonistic qualities. Layers of perfectly ripe fruit intertwine on a supple framework of tannin that gives structure, along with a foundation for aging this

masterpiece.
